Initially you will be responsible for the operational management of offender mental health and substance misuse services within HMP Wandsworth as part of the newly established Secure Healthcare consortium, which will be responsible for the delivery of all aspects of healthcare in the prison. You will rotate with the current Service Manager in the Shaftesbury Clinic, and will be responsible for the management of inpatient forensic services. The Shaftesbury Clinic offers forensic services across South West London, Surrey and West Sussex. It comprises a 74-bedded medium/low secure unit, dedicated community and sex offender services and a posttraumatic stress disorder clinic and is based at Springfield University Hospital.
