


Listening to patients

West Hertfordshire Primary Care Trust Local Health Services Survey Results



Survey results

This report sets out the results from the 2008 National Patients Local Health Services Survey ordered in exactly the same way as in the core survey questionnaire sent to patients.

• HOW TO READ THE COLUMNS OF FIGURES

The results are shown firstly in absolute numbers then as percentages. The first pair of columns show the results from 2008 and the second pair of columns show the results from all the Primary Care Trusts surveyed by Quality Health in 2008 (ALL).

The purpose of presenting the figures in this way is to give direct, at-a-glance, comparisons between the Trust and other Primary Care Trusts in the Quality Health database in 2008.

CONVENTIONS

The percentages are calculated after excluding those patients who did not answer that particular question. All percentages are rounded to the nearest whole number. When added together, the percentages for all answers to a particular question may not total 100% because of this rounding.

The 'Missing' figures show the number of patients who did not reply to that particular question. In some cases, the 'Missing' figure is quite high because it includes patients who did not answer that question or group of questions because it was not applicable to their circumstances (e.g. question A3).

On some questions there are also some figures which are italicised. The percentages on these questions have been recalculated to exclude responses where the question was not applicable to the patient's circumstances. For example, questions such as C12 which asks if the patient was given enough time to discuss their health or medical problem with the doctor, where both those not answering (Missing) and those saying they did not need to discuss anything are excluded from the percentage calculations.

+ CHANGES MADE TO THE DATA

There are a number of questions which are 'routed' (i.e. where patients are directed to a subsequent question depending on their answer to the lead question). Sometimes there are conflicts in the answers that patients give to these questions and the data is corrected to account for this. For example, if answer 2 in question 1 is ticked and the patient goes on to answer question 2 etc, then any data between question 1 and question 6 (where the patient was directed) will be deleted as the patient should not have answered these questions. Where patients have not answered a lead question but have gone on to answer subsequent questions, then it is assumed that they should have ticked a positive response in the lead question and where this is possible (i.e. there is only one positive response possible), then the data is changed to reflect this.
