# **Enuresis: Nocturnal**

# Management

## **Primary Care management includes**

- reassurance below the age of 7 years
- standard home alarm clock and dry bed training

### Specialist management includes

- investigation and advice on management of persistent nocturnal enuresis
- enuresis alarm
- desmopressin

## When to refer

#### **Refer to CAS**

- Consider referring to the local enuresis advisor/enuresis clinic (where available) all children aged over 7 years who have persistent nocturnal enuresis despite initial treatment.
- Refer to appropriate specialist:
  - If an enuresis advisor is not available and there is no response to appropriate treatment
  - All children with urinary tract infections, daytime wetting, or other organic causes of enuresis

#### Refer to RARC

• if the patient does not meet the referral criteria above consider referral to CAS requesting a RARC appointment.
